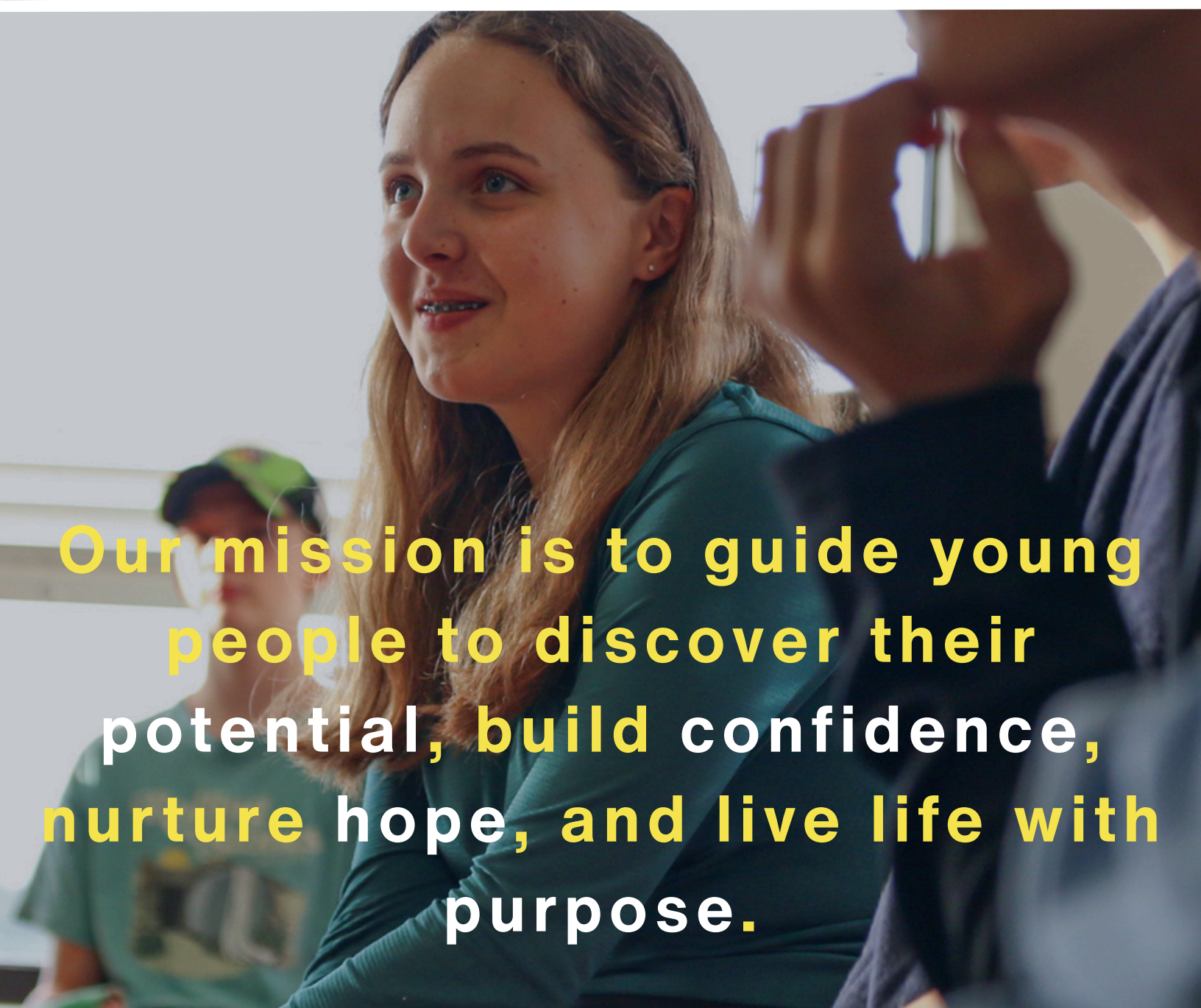

Out of 24 current tenants, many have started new jobs, internships, work-study programs, and classes.

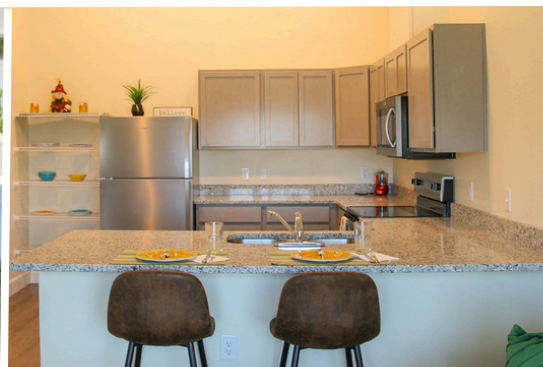
On June 11th, we held a ribbon cutting event for Capernaum Place.

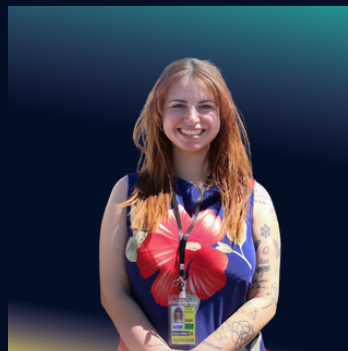

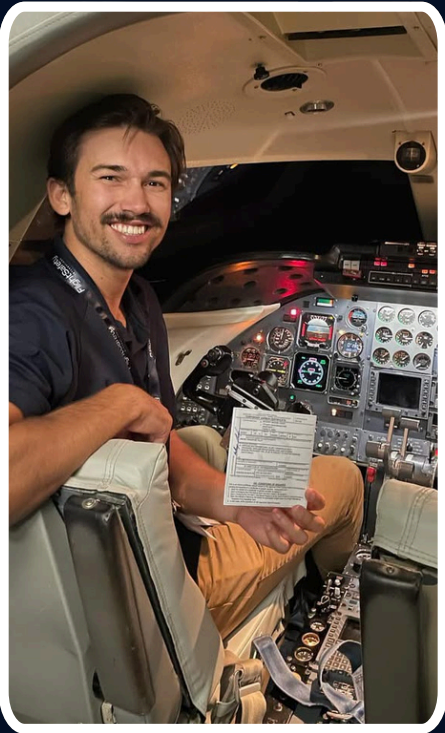

Anthony's Testimony

When Anthony was a teenager, he already knew he wanted a life in the sky. His dad was a Southwest pilot, and airplanes were part of his world from the time he could talk.

“Since I could talk, that was my favorite books, those were my favorite toys,” he said. “I knew what I was doing from pretty much as soon as I could talk and communicate what I wanted to do, I knew what I wanted to do. So aviation’s always been a part of my life.”

A friend invited him to Wings of Grace in Melbourne when he was 14. At first, it just felt like an after-school activity.

“At first, Wings of Grace started to me as just after-school camp,” Anthony said. “It was what we did on Tuesday nights, and we got to fly airplanes, and that was cool too. But it was more than that. It was a place to go after school. It was the hangout.”

That “hangout” quickly became a place where Anthony learned to work, lead, and serve. He and the other students helped with home renovation projects, airport tasks, and practical jobs.
